Dr Pedro Ciudad is a board certified plastic surgeon from Peru. He has the following postgraduate degrees: Fellowship in Advanced Reconstructive Microsurgery, PhD in Tissue Engineering and Regenerative Medicine and Doctorate in Lymphatic Surgery. He spent 7 years in Taiwan and worked as an Assistant Professor and Clinical Instructor in the Department of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at the China Medical University Hospital in Taiwan.

Currently, he is working as head of the Microsurgery Unit at the Department of Plastic, Reconstructive and Burn Surgery at the Arzobispo Loayza National Hospital in Lima-Peru. He is an Assistant Professor at Federico Villarreal National University Academic Department of Surgery

He has vast experience in microsurgical reconstruction of the breast, head and neck, extremity reconstruction, gender affirmation surgery and also super/microsurgery for lymphedema. Moreover, he has described several new techniques in the surgical treatment of lymphedema and other complex reconstructions.

Dr Ciudad has published over 180 peer-reviewed research articles, he has coedited a textbook book on the surgical treatment of Lymphedema and has contributed chapters for different books in plastic surgery.
